

MAC 2006 STUDENT PAPER COMPETITION

Announcing the

2nd Annual MAC Student Paper Competition

Deadline: September 25, 2006

All students of Midwestern Archaeology are invited to submit a paper that addresses the prehistory, ethnohistory, or historical archaeology of the Midwest. Three judges will judge the papers based upon clarity of presentation, logic of the argument, and quality of content. The winner will receive books donated to the competition by book vendors participating in the conference.

Requirements:

The paper must be presented at the 2006 MAC Annual Meeting. As such, it is the responsibility of the author to submit a paper proposal and registration to the Organizers of the 2006 MAC Conference. Only papers with a single author are eligible and the author must be affiliated with a degree granting institution. When submitting the digital copy of the paper for consideration, the student must send only the version that is to be presented at the conference; longer digital copies will not be accepted. The paper will be judged both on the content and presentation at the conference.

How to apply:

A digital double-spaced copy of the paper should be submitted to Eve Hargrave (ehargrav@uiuc.edu) by September 25, 2006. This will be forwarded to the competition judges at that time.

The winner will be announced at the 2006 Annual MAC Business meeting.
