

Appendix A. Catalog Information from Keyes Archaeological Record Book.

Information is duplicated on handwritten notes in the artifact collection for each cataloged unit.

Tiffany comments with catalog numbers are in italics with minor editorial changes for consistency of presentation.

E. H. Hawbaker Donations

Hn1-55H lithics picked up by Angstrom boys *on or near* Angstrom Village, donations by Hawbaker 27 March 1930 and 23 May 1931 and 5 Nov 1933.

Hn1-56H *found on* Angstrom Village site donation 27 March 1930.

Hn1-57H flint hoe *found* by Andrew Angstrom *on* Angstrom Village site, donated by Hawbaker 27 March 1930.

Hn1-58H flints found *on or near* Angstrom Village site; gift to SHS by E. H. Hawbaker, 27 March 1930. *Points include earlier Late Archaic and Woodland forms pre-dating the Great Oasis site component.*

Hn1-59H small arrowheads *found mostly* by Angstrom boys *on* the Angstrom Village site, Hawbaker donation, 27 March 1930. *Several Late Woodland corner notched points are untyped, but clearly Late Woodland forms.*

Hn1-60H broken artifacts and flint refuse found by the Angstrom boys *on or near* the Angstrom Village; Hawbaker Donation 27 March 1930.

Hn1-61H 38 potsherds *from* the Angstrom Village, 4 donations dating 1928, 1930, 1931, and 1933.

Hn1-62H mostly pottery *from* the Angstrom Village (few lithics, charcoal); north of an E–W ditch, found with fragments of a large bowl (*sic seed jar*) restored by the MPM (*Milwaukee Public Museum*) *see Hn1-843 below*; Hawbaker gift, various times 1930–1933.

Hn1-73H *on or near* Angstrom Village, found by Angstrom boys, 1930 gift.

Hn1-107 2 hematite celts, lithics; farmyard Angstrom site *bordering site* to the NE; gift 4 Nov 1933.

Hn1-161 pottery from the Angstrom Village site 23 July 1928. Additional pottery from W ½, SW ¼, Sec. 31, T87N, R26W, 27 March 1930, April 1931, 5 Nov 1933.

Hn1-677 pottery, large split chert cobble.

Hn1-843 large, mouthed woodland bowl (*seed jar*) restored by the MPM from fragments found by Peter T. Angstrom and Frank A. (*illegible*) on North end of Angstrom site; height 8.5 in; dia. 10 in. *Location of seed jar illustrated in Keyes photo (HN-01-2-1) in this report.*

Hawbaker collected the following from the Angstrom site, probably from several visits in spring/summer/summer 1940.

Hn1-1H mostly fragments of a single vessel, collected by Hawbaker from Angstrom Village, 1940 [*includes lithics, section of turtle carapace*].

Hn-2808 surface finds, NW site edge, collected by Hawbaker, donation 10 July 1940.

Hn-2809 pottery and other items collected by Hawbaker, no precise location, *on or near the Angstrom site*, donated 10 July 1940.

Hn-2810 scattered finds [*lithics*] made by Hawbaker, spring 1940; gift of Hawbaker 10 July 1940.

Humble Village site (13HM2), Wedel excavation, 1938.

Hn-2198; restored Hitchell Tool Impressed, *OSA Acc:10928*, Refuse Mound 3, Level 1 *illustrated in this report.*

Hn-2786 rim sherds, Humble Village; Refuse Mound 1, Level 2, Kantor and Mott July 1938.

Hn-2787 flint and bone refuse, Refuse Mound 1, Level 2.

Hn-2788 pottery Refuse Mound 1, Level 1.

Hn-2789 pottery Refuse Mound 1, Level 2, *some sherds removed to Iowa Hall.*

Hn-2790 pebble, *probable surface find.*

Hn-2791 Refuse Mound 3, Level 2, 1938.

Hn-2791a pottery Refuse Mound 3, Level 1, 1938.

Hn-2791b pottery, flakes; probably Refuse Mound 3, no level.

Hn-2792 Refuse Mound 3, Level 2, pottery; *sherds do not have catalog numbers on them.*

Hn-2793 Refuse Mound 2, no level; Humble site, Kantor/Mott, 1939.

Hn-2794 Trench A, Humble site; Kantor/Mott, 1939.
